  - 12 attendees

- 2. Approval of the minutes from the January 28th PAC meeting

- 3. Presentation on emergency preparedness & SD61 reunification procedures from <u>Sarah Hunn</u>, Emergency Management Community Liaison, City of Victoria and <u>Marketa Lund</u> of Ground Zero Consulting Group (30 minutes) – recording available here.
  - There are 2 types of releases:
    - Controlled student release Students will be released to parents as they are available.
    - Post-disaster reunifications There will be a double-gate system. Authorized guardians (those listed on the emergency release forms parents/guardians filled out in September) will check in at the area marked #1 and will be verified. Staff will bring the child to the guardian at the checkout gate (marked #2) where they will then exit together.
  - It is important that all guardians have up-to-date student release forms at the school and have provided copy to those people who are on the release list. Guardians should also ensure that they have an emergency plan.
  - Visit <u>victoriaready.ca</u> for detailed information on emergency preparedness and download the Alertable app (<u>Apple</u> or <u>Google Play</u>) to be notified of local emergencies. This system is different from the provincial emergency notification system.
- 4. Parent Committees and Event Updates
  - Pink Shirt Day: ~ 100 pink shirts were sold and funds raised will be donated to the CKNW
    Pink Shirt Day Fund
  - Purdys Fundraiser ~ \$400.00 has been raised so far.
  - o **Growing Smiles Fundraiser** 
    - Funds raised will go to the garden committee to help cover Growing Young Farmers program fees.
    - This will start after spring break and items will be delivered on May 4<sup>th</sup> (before Mother's Day).
    - Fundraising target is \$2,000.
  - o Everyone Rides bike skills program
    - Free program offered through Bike Victoria (will replace iRide this year).

- Course will include road safety and on-bike skills and will be offered to grade 4 and 5 students.
- o Grade 5 Bottle Drive April 10th
  - Will be a drive through drop off following COVID protocol.
  - Funds raised will go to Grade 5 Camp Thunderbird.
- 5. PAC Executive volunteer opportunities
  - o Positions vacant for 2021/22: (co) Chair, Treasurer, Secretary
  - Looking for new parents to help fill these roles.
  - These roles are necessary to function as a PAC.
- 6. Teachers' update (Ashley Frketich, 10 min)
  - Thank you for the staff appreciation lunch.
- 7. Administration's update (James & Lindsay, 10 min)
  - Working on the projector quote for the gym.
  - Thank you for the funds that will go to purchasing playground supplies. The items purchased will make a big difference.
  - Crossing guard position is still available.
  - Requesting feedback from parents on whether their children have enough time available for lunch.
  - 4 or the 7 classrooms that were waiting for sinks are almost installed. The remaining 3 classrooms will be completed by June.
  - o Report cards will be coming out near Spring Break.
  - Staff is going through emergency supplies to confirm what is current and what needs to be replaced. Will let PAC know how they can help replenish stock of perishable items.
  - Middle Years Development Instrument results will be coming out shortly, it was completed by Grade 4's and it will provide good feedback for the school.
  - o Foundation Skills Assessment (FSA) testing has started for Grade 4's.
  - Grade 5 leadership just finished up with French grade 5s Pink Shirt Day activities. Next session with English grade 5s – will start working on posters for the bottle drive, and organize a spirit day for the school.

  - A: No replacement yet still working through the process. Class may have substitute teachers for the week before spring break.
