As a parent or guardian of an ÉMJS student, YOU are automatically a PAC member! The ÉMJS PAC is a central part of the school community, where successful education and well-being of our children depends on teachers, students, parents, and the administration all working together. Through the PAC, parent volunteers play critical roles in fundraising and supporting school and PAC-led events that enrich student experience and help sustain the ÉMJS community. **The PAC is entirely volunteer -run and we are always in need of more volunteers!**

PAC funds support activities, programs and equipment including:

- Chess lessons, Science Venture, Hop-On (cycling skills program), classroom supplies, visiting performers and field trips;
- Technology (iPads, ChromeBooks), art supplies, classroom stationary bikes, playground and sports equipment, emergency supplies and musical instruments;
- Special annual events like the Grade 5 year-end trip and celebrations.

PAC Fundraising

PAC funds support activities, programs and equipment that would otherwise not be possible on

school district funds alone! In 2022/23 (budget on our website: <u>emjs.hotlunches.net</u>), PAC funds supported the following (either in full or partially):

- PAC LUNCH program: This is our main fundraiser for general PAC initiatives. Each month (often the 2nd Wednesday), PAC offers a variety of lunch items that parents can purchase in advance on our website: <u>emjs.hotlunches.net</u>. Watch for order details in our <u>September newsletters</u>.

- WALK-A-THON: For the past 2 years, PAC has organized a very successful spring Walk-a-Thon as a fundraiser for a <u>new outdoor classroom and ecological learning lab</u>. This is a 3- to 5-year PAC initiative; you can read more about this exciting project on our website: <u>emjs.hotlunches.net</u>
- Many of our fundraising events also create important <u>community-building opportunities</u>, bringing families together at events such as a Fall Dance (October) and Spring Fair (June). Without ÉMJS parent volunteers and support of PAC events, our school would be a very different place!
- PAC funds support events for parents too, including <u>Parent Education sessions</u>. PAC hosts guest speakers on topics such as children's internet safety & screen time, children's anxiety, sexual health education, and others. Watch for notices in our newsletter about upcoming sessions!
- **Donations to the PAC are welcome at any time**. Order School Supplies From Monk Office

Simplify your back-to-school shopping and have Monk Office deliver your child(ren)'s school supplies to their classroom in September! Using school supply lists from ÉMJS teachers, we worked with Monk to put together grade-specific kits that you can order online, and have delivered to your child(ren)'s classroom(s) in September. Monk generously donates 10% of sales to the ÉMJS PAC for us to put toward programs for the 2023/24 school year. You also have the option to donate \$5 to the PAC with your order.

To order for the 2023/24 school year:

- To start shopping go to <u>bts.monk.ca</u> and use the **PAC CODE: 330CB3**
- Select the **grade** and **language** (FR/EN) that your child will be in NEXT YEAR and add that kit to your cart. The kits automatically contain all the items marked "required" on the school supply lists provided by ÉMJS teachers. Select additional optional items to add to your cart if needed.
- During checkout you can pay with **Visa or Mastercard** and choose **free school delivery** (to your child(ren)'s ÉMJS classroom in September), **free in-store pickup**, or **home delivery**.

ORDERING WILL OPEN: June 5, 2023

ORDERING WILL CLOSE (for school delivery): JULY 19, 2023 Note: this is the deadline for selecting "deliver to school" in September; after this the only shipping options will be in-store pickup or home delivery. For reference, the 2023/24 ÉMJS supply lists are posted on the school website (under the Student Info tab).

- Safe & Active Routes to School: Help with Walk & Wheel to School week and other active transportation initiatives.

Time during the day? Some in-school opportunities include:

- Hot Lunch Servers: 2nd Wednesday of each month, 11:00-12:30;
- Class Parent: Communicate PAC events to other parents in your child's class;
- Odd Jobs: help decorate bulletin boards, make & post signs for events.

Time in the evenings or on weekends? Help us coordinate/manage:

- Convening guest speakers (Parent Education);
- Emergency preparedness: help the school inventory and replenish supplies periodically;
- School supplies fundraiser with Monk Office;
- Grant writing: help us secure funding for PAC initiatives;
- School-branded clothing
- Volunteer Coordinator: help manage volunteers and our volunteer sign-up website for hot lunch days and other PAC-led events.

Big Events (great single focus events for parents who have limited spare time!):

- Fall Dance & Spring Fair: staff a booth; help set up/clean up; serve food; decorate!
- Winter Make Sale: (Early December) Donate materials, or help on the day.
